Safeguarding

As part of our commitment to keeping our children safe and informed, we are raising awareness about potential dangers in an age-appropriate way. Through discussions, stories, and activities, we aim to help children understand the importance of making safe choices and speaking to a trusted adult if they ever feel worried. We recently invited PC Liam Davies and our local PSCOs to deliver an assembly about knife crime to KS2 and meet with all children to talk about staying safe. While knife crime is rare in our community, education and early conversations play a vital role in prevention. We will be continuing to keep the conversation at the forefront of staff training and continue to address the topic with children at an age-appropriate way through out PSHE curriculum and School Values Assemblies. We continue to discourage children from bringing in any items from home other than their school equipment. Please support us with this.
