Practice Carol Service at City Life Church

Y's 2, 3 & 4 will be having a practice for their carol service at City Life Church on Monday 15th Dec. The children will be walking to and from the Church in the afternoon and will be back for normal pick up time. Please ensure you child has a coat on that day.

We have been made aware of a pop-up that is appearing on Roblox, encouraging children to download an app called pollybuzz (or pollyfuzz in some spelling cases). The app seems quite simple. Children are asked questions and it generates an Artificial Intelligence 'friend'. This starts off quite innocently but then begins to show extreme content (including suicide, self-harm and pornography).

We encourage you to remind children about not clicking on pop-ups in games and to report anything that is worrying or inappropriate to a trusted adult. We will do the same at school. Roblox has parental controls and instructions for how to put these on can be accessed via this link:

However, please be aware that parental controls will stop some pop-ups but not all, so appropriate supervision is still required.

As ever, we urge you to be vigilant about your child's use of devices and access online, to monitor your child's activity carefully and to talk to them about what they are playing.

Wrap around care

Our breakfast and after school club are for Years R-6 providing care 7.30-6.00. Please book via MCAS App. These are becoming very popular so it is important you book and pay for your child's session as soon as you know you will need a space. We cannot guarantee a space will be available for last minute bookings. We will be looking to employ additional staff so we can increase numbers.

The Breakfast and After School Club policies are on our website. We require at least 24 hours notice to cancel a place or you will be charged the full cost of the space.

Please note we are now a cashless school.

Currently we are unable to offer wrap around care for pre-school children (Due to lack of take up and recruitment). This is being kept under review
