We have had a fun filled and exciting half term in after school club. We have enjoyed messy play making 'oobleck' (a cornstarch and water mixture). This is a fantastic sensory play which is solid when squeezed but flows like water when it is left to sit. Oobleck great for fine motor skill development and also relaxing to play with. 
