Timetable of the days

Thursday

8:15am – children arrive in school with their packed lunch and water bottle at 08:15am. Please drop off their labelled sleepover items to the cabin in the main playground. The coach will be leaving promptly at 9am and we are unable to wait for latecomers.

The children can wear non-uniform for the trip to Paultons Park, please make sure they wear suitable shoes as we will be doing a lot of walking. Please also ensure that they are dressed appropriately for the weather e.g. raincoats or sun hat and sun cream.

We will be having fun spending the day at Paultons Park and taking part in a rollercoaster forces workshop where the children will take charge of their own K'Nex ride in a session which explores the physics behind a rollercoaster.

We will return to school at 5pm for a sleepover. The children will then have tea from the chip shop, an evening activity, a little snack and a bedtime drink. Please refrain from attempting to see children when they return.

After breakfast the children will walk to the Andrew Simpson Centre, which is based on the Eastern Road, the centre is an approved watersports provider for schools. Children will take part in a range of paddlesport activities including some kayaking, SUPs, mega SUPs and canoe rafting. We will have lunch at the centre and then walk back to school. 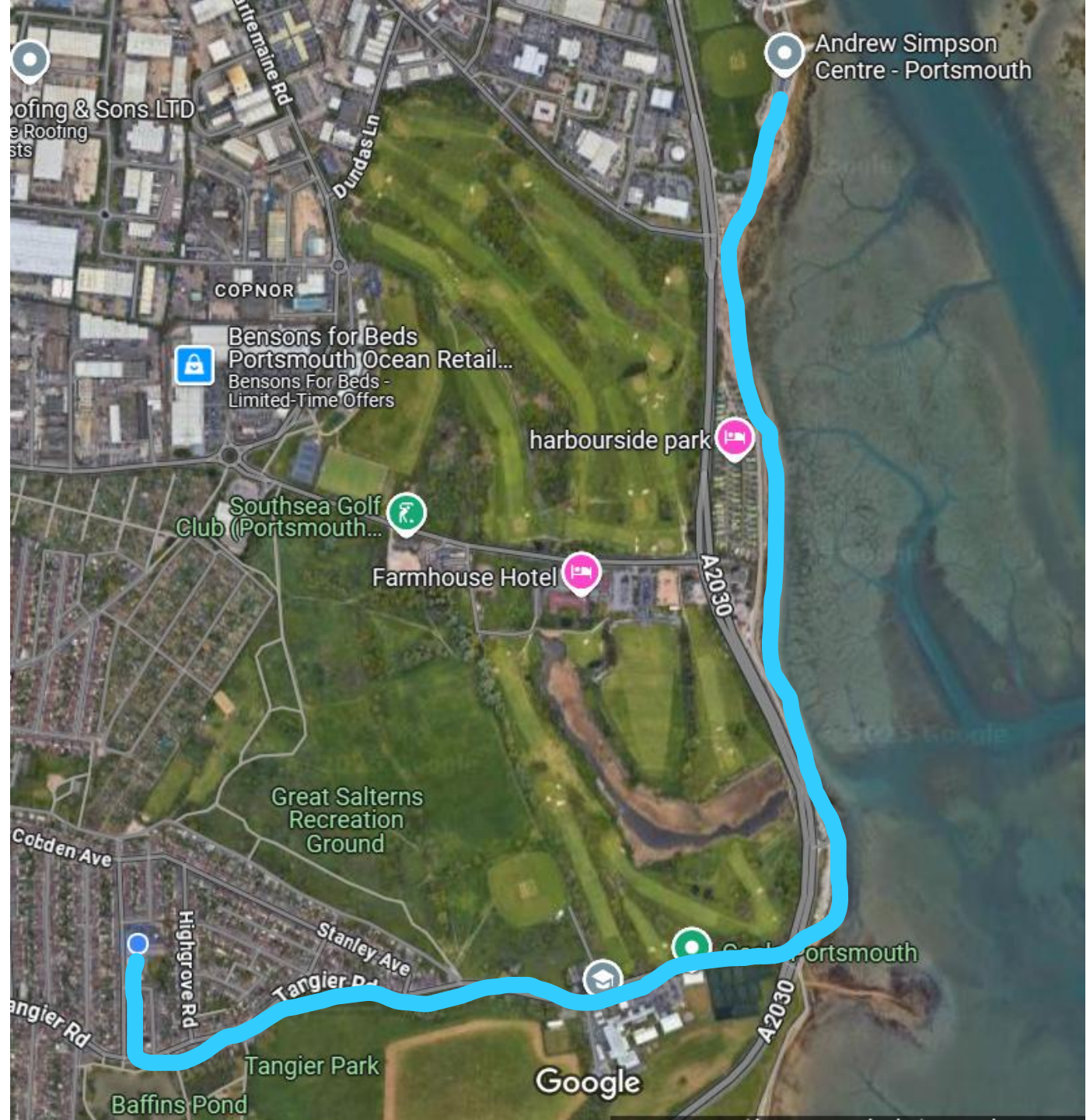
Sleeping Arrangements
