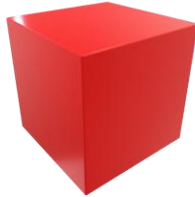


Year R – Home Learning. 3D Shape Hunt

If you get the chance, see what shapes you can find around the home.

Show or draw each shape (or use toys/household items)

Say the names together:



Cube → like a dice

Sphere → like a ball



Cylinder → like a can



Cone → like an ice cream cone



Ask simple questions:

“Which one rolls?”

“Which one has flat faces?”

Main Activity: Scavenger Hunt (15–20 mins)

Task:

Ask your child to search around the house to find objects for each shape.

Example checklist:

Cube → a box, dice

Sphere → a ball, orange

Cylinder → a tin, toilet roll

Cone → party hat, funnel

Make it fun:

Give them a basket or bag

Let them bring items back to a “shape station”

Talk & Explore (5–10 mins)

Look at each item together and ask:

“What shape is this?”

“How do you know?”

“Can it roll or stack?”

Encourage simple describing words:

flat

round

pointy

curved
